

Fifth Grade Supply List for 2010 - 2011

☺ → these items will need to be replenished throughout the year

- 1-1/2" View Binder (has see-through plastic pocket on the front cover)
- 1 set "Big Tab Two Pocket Insertable Plastic Dividers" (by Avery; 8 tabs)
- Pocket folder, without center fasteners
- 3 packages of binder paper (wide-ruled) ☺
- 2 spiral notebooks ☺
- At least 2 dozen #2 pencils ☺ (**NO MECHANICAL PENCILS, NO PENCILS WITH "FUN" TOPS**)
- 2 red ball point pens ☺
- 5 glue sticks ☺
- Crayons (16 or 24 pack only) ☺
- Pre-sharpened colored pencils (8-12 count) ☺
- Colored markers (unscented, no more than 8) ☺
- 2 black or blue ball point pens (erasable OK) ☺ **NO GEL PENS**
- 4 highlighters: Sharpie Accent Highlighter brand OR Avery Hi-Liter brand in basic colors of yellow, pink, green and blue ☺
- 2-3 black, *Ultra Fine Point Sharpie Permanent Markers* ☺
- 2-3 black, *Fine Point Sharpie Permanent Markers* ☺
- 1-2 white bar erasers (Pentel Hi-Polymer brand) ☺
- 1 pair scissors
- 1 manual pencil sharpener (not electric/battery operated)
- 12" ruler w/metric measurement
- Homework assignment notebook/planner with spaces to write out assignments (NOT a pocket calendar)
NOTE: A regular spiral notebook is also fine to use for a Homework Assignment notebook.
- Basic calculator
- Pouch to hold pens/pencils and supplies—fabric is best (**NO PENCIL BOXES**)
- 6 Book covers (the Social Studies and Science books need very large covers)
