

## BOOK REPORT IDEAS

Choose ONE of the following ideas to present your Favorite Book of the Quarter in class.

Due on the last week of each quarter! – Students will randomly pick a date to present.

1. **Fashion a mobile** from items related to the story. Explain why did you choose those particular items, why are they important, and what do they represent/symbolize.
2. Make a **wanted poster** for one of the characters in the book. Explain who the character is and why you chose him or her.
3. Make an **A to Z book** to tell the story and describe the main characters in you book. Write a sentence with each letter of the alphabet.
4. Make a **travel poster** describing the location of the book's action.
5. Shrink down the entire book into a **narrative poem**.
6. Choose a container to make your **time capsule** (shoebox, oatmeal canister, coffee can, gift box. Cover your container with paper. (Teacher can supply if needed!) Decorate the lid of your time capsule with the book title and author. Include your name as well. Decorate the sides of your time capsule with pictures that shows the overall theme of the book. Choose 5 items that match the narrative elements (characters, setting, problem, solution, theme) of your book. Fill in the chart on the back once you have chosen items. You can also draw an item or print a picture of an item, too.
7. Make a **NEW book jacket**. It should include an attractive picture or cover design, an original summary of the book, information on the author and illustrator, and information about other books by the author.
8. **Interview a character** from your book. Write at least ten questions that will give the character the opportunity to discuss his/her thoughts and feelings about his/her role in the story. You may ask a classmate to help with your presentation. However, you are responsible to write up the character's responses.
9. Use a **collage** to represent the mood of the book and its theme.
10. Write a **comic book** version of your book. Use a storyboard, show the 6 most important events of the book. Write a short caption under each event.
