



WEEKLY SPELLING CONTRACT

This spelling contract is a great way to study your spelling words!

You may choose any of the activities from the chart, but you should have **at least 50 points**. Attach all of your work to the spelling definition list. This homework is meant to help you practice the words and study for the test. Do NOT wait until Thursday night to do all of your activities! You will receive a grade that corresponds to the amount of activities you complete. Spelling contracts are **due every other FRIDAY! Have fun!**

#	ACTIVITIES	Point Value
1	Put the words in ABC order.	5
2	Write each word three times.	5
3	Write each word neatly in pen (you may use any color!).	5
4	Write your words in order from longest word to shortest word.	5
5	Write each word and circle all of the vowels OR all of the consonants.	5
6	Draw a picture to help you remember each word.	10
7	Divide each spelling word into syllables.	10
8	Type each word 4 times each on the computer.	10
9	Write a synonym OR an antonym for each word.	10
10	Scramble the words, give them to a friend to solve, and then correct it.	10
11	Solve a friend's scramble.	10
12	Word hunt: Cut the words out of magazines or newspapers and glue them to a paper.	15
13	Have someone (parent or classmate) give you a practice test of the words and correct it. Friend or parent signature required.	15
14	Write sentences using the words. (one sentence for each word)	15
15	Write tongue twisters with the words.	20
16	Sort the spelling words using your own categories.	20
17	Write a story using all the spelling words.	25
18	Write a poem using all your spelling words.	25
19	Pretend you are a news anchor, weather person, or reporter. Using your spelling words, write a report.	25
20	Create a comic strip and write captions using your spelling words.	25
21	Find and copy the sentences that contain the spelling words from the book/story we are reading. Highlight the words in the sentences. (Only when your spelling words come from the book or story we are reading in class!)	20
