Quality of Information	Includes all five parts (original introduction, relevant facts, examples, connection to <i>Tangerine</i> , and conclusion) of the research, of which each is thoroughly described throughout the course of the paper. 30-29	Includes all five parts of the research, of which all but one answer is thoroughly described throughout the course of the paper 28-27	Includes some parts of the research, of which some lack sufficient description. Some of the information is copied. 26-25	Information is simply copied and pasted from sources and not put in student's own words or has little or nothing to do with the research.
