Dear Preschool Parents:

We are pleased to announce that we have PASSED our unannounced Annual/Random visit, which is performed by California Department of Social Services Community Care Licensing Division. The Licensing evaluator was happy with our record keeping. She also felt that your teachers are above and beyond the requirements necessary to be a qualified preschool teacher. As parents you should feel proud and happy that your child is attending preschool in a safe, caring, and educationally rich environment.

After our parade, the children may play outside until school is over. Then we will see you at our school Halloween Carnival at 1-3pm. Bring a container or a bag to carry their carnival prizes. If your child does not attend school on this day, they may come to school at 11:00 to participate in the parade or at 10:30 to enjoy pizza. Do not forget to bring 2 bags of candy to the office. Each family is asked to bring a cake or baked item for the cake walk.
