Coach's Duties and Responsibilities

**To be signed by anyone coaching a sporting event representing Madonna del Sasso School. If anyone coaches more than one sport, only one copy of this form needs to be signed.*

1. Conduct oneself according to the school's mission and philosophy.
2. Promote Christian values that enhance a strong athletic foundation.
3. Nurture the student-athlete's growth of character and self esteem.
4. Develop a positive parent/coach/athlete relationship.
5. Promote respect, good sportsmanship and obedience towards authority figures by treating student-athletes, their parents, opponents and game officials with respect.
6. Instruct each student-athlete as to the rules of the sport through regular practices and in game competition.
7. Maintain constant supervision of student-athletes until all of them have been picked up; students should never be left alone after practices or games.
8. Check students in and out of school extended care before 6:00pm as needed.
9. Communicate with the Athletic Director regarding games and practice schedules.
10. Confirm game dates and times with other league schools when necessary.
11. Organize carpool transportation to and from games.
12. Encourage 5th/6th grade families to bring their own student-athletes to athletic events, as is customary.
13. Maintain inventory of all team equipment (e.g. uniforms, gear, balls, and first aid).
14. Insure proper registration and emergency information for each student-athlete before he/she is permitted to practice (copies for each student-athlete must always be kept on file with the school, coach, and with parent drivers providing transportation).
15. Coaches will be responsible for completing and abiding by the Student Activity Center (SAC) Use Agreement form.
